Through a careful screening of our current student population, you have been identified as a potential Gilman International Scholarship applicant. The U.S. Department of State's <u>Gilman Scholarship Program</u> is an undergraduate grant program for U.S. citizens of limited financial means to enable them to study or intern abroad, thereby internationalizing their outlook and better preparing them to thrive in the global economy. The program provides awards of up to \$5,000 for students who are U.S. citizens, Federal Pell Grant recipients, and studying at undergraduate level at a two or four-year institution. Studying abroad during your undergraduate career can be a life-changing experience. Additionally, receiving a Gilman Scholarship and studying abroad will make you a more competitive candidate for jobs, other scholarships, and admission to graduate programs.
