Keep it high-res, no low quality images.



Stay in focus. We think you're sharp but blurry photos are not!



Photos provided should include description and impact of the Gilman Program.



Be **SELECTIVE**. No more than 5 photos allowed.




Please submit original photos without filters or editing.




Please, no large group shots. We want to see you!
