

Hussein’s experiences traveling the country during his five-week long program in Morocco broadened his perspective of the diversity in certain regions of the country. He credits the connections made with other students as one of the most important aspects of his study abroad experience.

Hussein’s time in Morocco inspired him to continue his role as a global citizen, and since returning from his program he has become a member of the United Nations Association through which he lobbied for the interests of the United Nations on topics such as refugee immigration, sustainability, and international affairs to his congressional and senatorial representatives from Arizona. He has worked with Arizona State University to create a coalition of sustainability clubs, and recently began working at Halsten Enterprise, an organization that promotes projects articulated into the United Nations Millennium Development Goals.
