9. Description of Amendment/Modification: The purpose of this solicitation amendment is to inform prospective offerors that the above numbered solicitation is hereby amended to provide responses to questions as follows.

The request for proposals would likely open in late Fall 2020, though this timing may shift.

- 2. I'm wondering if you'll offer these seminars in the summer of 2021. If so, when would proposals open for that (around December, again?)?**

Pending funding, the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs anticipates holding U.S. Future Leaders Seminars in 2021. The request for proposals would likely open in late Fall 2020, though this timing may shift.

- 3. Many groups call [city name] their summer home. Are you looking for two nights residency or one?**
