April/May 2020 Status of Abroad Programs The Gilman Program sent a survey to all Gilman advisors to collect updates on their campuses' status and their work status.

The survey was open from April 22 – May 7. The survey returned over 400 respondents representing 360 institutions.

Study Abroad Programs Status at Institutions


Summer 2020 programs have been cancelled for the majority of survey respondents' institutions. The majority of respondents also reported the status of future programs in Fall 2020, Spring 2021, and AY 2020-2021 as "To Be Determined."

Alternate Options for Study Abroad Provided by Institutions

Most advisors (64%) reported that either their institution is providing alternatives or is determining next steps on options.

Is your institution providing alternative options for study or intern abroad students?



If advisors' institutions were providing alternate options, the most popular option made available for students whose programs were canceled was providing them with the choice to defer their program acceptance to a later term. Respondents were allowed to select multiple options.
