This July 2020 survey was open from July 15 – July 21. The survey returned 71 responses.


## Study Abroad Programs Status at Institutions

Almost half of the advisors report that Fall 2020 abroad programs have been canceled and 0% are resuming. Compared to the last survey, there is more confirmation on the status of programs.
