

Update to Funds Disbursement Policy

Effective for the following deadline applications with program start dates on or after February 14, 2022:

March 2021, October 2021, March 2022

Options for Active Gilman Recipients

program starts before 2/14/2022

program starts on or after 2/14/2022



Latest Program Start Dates for Each Application Deadline

March 2021 Deadline --> April 30, 2022 | October 2021 Deadline --> October 30, 2022 | March 2022 Deadline --> April 30, 2023

Gilman funding emergency support from the Gilman Program while abroad Gilman alumni benefits re-apply for future application

*Students must meet Gilman eligibility criteria while participating in a new program submitted via program change | **Virtual programs approved through April 30, 2023 start dates

Gilman Scholar: Student who participates in a program in a Level 1, 2, or [Approved Level 3 location](#), or virtual program** will participate in their program as a Gilman Scholar. Gilman Scholars have access to emergency support from the Gilman Program while abroad and receive Gilman alumni benefits.

Gilman recipient: Student who participates in a program in a [location eligible to receive Gilman funds](#) that is not Level 1, 2, or [Approved Level 3 location](#) will participate in their program as a private citizen. They will be considered a Gilman recipient, though they will not be eligible for emergency support from the Gilman Program while abroad or Gilman alumni benefits.

Students who decline the scholarship due to Covid-19 and re-apply will be given priority consideration, as long as they still meet program eligibility requirements.
