## GILMAN-MCCAIN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PRE-CHECK

## Before you apply, use this checklist to make sure you have everything you need!

Check eligibility requirements: Make sure you and your program meet <u>all eligibility criteria</u>.

Have your DD1173/Military Dependent ID ready: Documentation that verifies your sponsor's activeduty status is required to submit with your application.

Request your unofficial transcript: Unofficial transcripts are acceptable to submit with your application. Recipients will submit official transcripts.

Gather your abroad program details: To learn more about the details you'll provide, review the <u>PDF</u> <u>version of the application</u>. Don't have finalized program details? Estimated dates and cost are acceptable to submit with the application.

Prepare to select certifying advisors: All applicants must select one study abroad advisor and one financial aid advisor within their application. Check the <u>Advisor Directory</u> to find advisors registered at your institution.

Begin drafting your essay responses: Writing your <u>three</u> required essays as early as possible gives you time to share drafts with others to proofread in advance of the deadline.
